Introduction

2026: The Year of the Wind of Heaven

Pastor Corey Erman – River Church WPB

I want to begin by sharing the word that the Lord gave me for 2026. This is something I have done for as long as I have been a pastor. I have been in full-time ministry for over 30 years, and for 26 going on 27 years, I have been pastoring. Every year, I press in to hear from the Lord for the upcoming year, and over the years, His word has come to me in various ways—through visions, dreams, times of fasting and prayer, or under the anointing as I speak it out.

It was on a Wednesday night before I left for our camp meeting in Istanbul, Turkey, that the Lord gave me this word. I was preaching at our Wednesday night service, and I was caught up in the Spirit. I began to declare that 2026 would be the year of the wind of heaven. About a week later, I traveled to Istanbul for our Eurasian camp meeting. While in my hotel on the night I arrived, I woke up in the middle of the night and heard the Lord say:

"Get ready for the winds of change. Get ready for the winds of change. They're going to be blowing in 2026."

I then went to the Word of God and studied the concept of the wind of heaven. The Lord began to reveal scriptures and powerful insights about what will happen in 2026. The first scripture I want to focus on is **John 3:8**.

Opening Prayer for 2026

Father, thank you as I bring forth the word that you dropped in my spirit for this upcoming year, 2026. Let everyone who has ears hear what the Spirit says to the churches. I pray that the entrance of your word brings light and that this word is not only heard, but this word is grabbed and taken in the spirits of people that hear it, and it energizes their faith, and they grab ahold of this word and they begin to plug into what heaven has for them. Then this word will continue to resonate in their spirit throughout the year, and all the things that you have for individuals, families, businesses, ministries, and this church will come to fruition, and not a single promise will be stolen or will be lost. As we grab ahold of this word, we will see the manifestation of it in many different areas in our lives, and that's my prayer as I release this word tonight, and as I speak it out by faith and people grab ahold of it by faith, and we come into agreement to see the manifestation of it in Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

Aligning with the Winds of Heaven

Jesus said in **John 3:8**:

"The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

The wind refers to the Holy Spirit. Throughout scripture, the wind of God represents divine activity. Wind is moving air; when it moves softly, it is a gentle breeze; when it moves violently, it can be a hurricane. The wind of God always brings divine activity.

The wind of God always refers to divine activity. So there's going to be divine activity here in 2026 as the Spirit of God moves, and it's going to happen in some different areas where the Lord has shown me what's going to happen. So I'm going to go to the Word and begin to show you some things, and the rest of this is all going to be based on Scripture. So prophetically, I'm just saying that it's going to be the year of the wind of heaven, but then there's going to be several different things that are going to happen as God moves. It's how God moves, and as God moves, the wind of heaven creates, delivers, corrects, revives, resurrects, directs, and expands.

Every time we see the wind of God or the wind of heaven in the Bible, we see these things happening: creation taking place, deliverance taking place, provision taking place, correction, revival, even resurrection, direction, and expansion. You know the Hebrew word for spirit is ruach, which means wind, and the Greek word is pneuma, which also means wind. Wind, breath, spirit—they're the same thing. So when God releases His wind, things move and things change, and things that were dead come alive.

One thing very important to understand is that Jesus said we do not control the wind. Wind blows where it wishes. It's by the will of God. The Spirit of God moves according to the will of God. Our job is to align with it. Our job is to align with the wind of God. This coming year in 2026, as you align with the wind of God, you're going to begin to see certain things.

Winds of Creation

Where there are winds of change, there is life and divine activation. God's wind brings order out of chaos. Jesus said in John 3:8:

"The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

The wind here refers to the Holy Spirit. Throughout Scripture, the wind of God is not just symbolic—it represents divine activity. Wind is moving air. If the air is not moving, there is no wind. If the air moves softly, it is just a gentle breeze. If it moves fast and furiously, it can become a hurricane. We know what a Cat 5 hurricane can do here in Florida. Amen. The wind of God always refers to divine activity, and in 2026, there will be divine activity as the Spirit of God moves.

The wind of heaven creates, delivers, corrects, revives, resurrects, directs, and expands. Every time we see the wind of God in the Bible, we see these things happening: creation taking place, deliverance taking place, provision taking place, correction, revival, even resurrection, direction, and expansion.

The Hebrew word for spirit is ruach, which means wind, and the Greek word is pneuma, which also means wind. Wind, breath, spirit—they are the same thing. When God releases His wind, things move, things change, and things that were dead come alive.

One thing very important to understand is that Jesus said we do not control the wind. “The wind blows where it wishes.” It is by the will of God. The Spirit of God moves according to the will of God. Our job is to align with it. Our job is to align with the wind of God. This coming year, as you align with the wind of God, you will begin to see certain things. God’s wind brings life where there is chaos.

In Genesis 1:1-2, it says:

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the Earth. The Earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.”

The Spirit of God began to move over the waters before there was light, before there was land, and before there was any structure. When the Earth was without form, void, and dark, the Spirit of God began to move. He moved in the midst of chaos.

Maybe your life feels disorderly, empty, confusing, or unproductive, and the wind of heaven is going to bring divine order out of chaos here in 2026. God does not improve chaos. He interrupts it, and He creates something new out of it. He brings something forth that is brand new. He brings light out of darkness and order out of chaos. Job 33:4 says:

“The Spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life.”

God is going to turn chaos into creation, confusion into clarity. Some of you need to be lifting your hands right now and begin to receive this. Say this: God is going to turn confusion into clarity. He’s going to turn barrenness into fruitfulness. He will turn brokenness into beauty in Jesus’ mighty name.

Different things will speak to different people. Maybe not right now, but three months down the line, something new will be sparked in your spirit. Six months down the line, new understanding will come. Keep this word fresh. Go back and listen to it. Keep brooding over it and let it marinate in your spirit. Amen.

Winds of Deliverance

God's wind will make a way where there seems to be no way. The Bible gives us a perfect example in **Exodus 14:21-22**:

"Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the Lord caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night and made the sea into dry land; and the waters were divided, so the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea on dry ground, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand and on their left hand."

The Israelites had left Egypt and found themselves trapped between Pharaoh's army and the Red Sea. On the left and the right were mountains, in front was the sea, and behind them was Pharaoh's army. It seemed like there was no way. But God's wind made a way. Not only did it separate the waters, but it also dried the wet land so that they could cross over on dry ground. This is supernatural deliverance of the wind of heaven making a way for God's people.

When you come to a place where it seems there is no way, there will come a sound from heaven, like a mighty rushing wind, and there will be supernatural deliverance. God also made a way to protect His people. After the Israelites crossed over, Pharaoh tried to follow, but he was buried in the sea of forgetfulness.

Some of you tonight are crossing over. You're crossing over on dry land as God is making a way for you, and you're coming into 2026. The Pharaoh that's been chasing you in 2025 is about to be buried in the sea of forgetfulness!

You know, there's something we need to always recognize in the Bible because we think of these stories and assume that Moses just stretched out his hand and—boom—literally within a split second, things happened. The Bible says it happened all night. It happened all night long, in the darkest time. God was moving in the darkest hour to make a way.

It's important to understand that God's deliverance often works in the night hours. Moses stretched out his hand, and the wind worked all night long. They could not really see what was happening, but they could hear it. Something was moving, and by morning, a way had been made. God often works while we wait. It's not always instant, but His power is active behind the scenes.

Listen, sometimes God does not remove the obstacle immediately, but He creates a path through it. Isaiah 43:2 says, “When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you.”

I'm going to tell you here in 2026: stand still and see the salvation of the Lord! Obey God in the simple thing, and it will be the greatest breakthrough of your life. Let the wind work while you wait. Those who wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength. They shall mount up on wings like eagles, and they will soar.

This is going to be a year of many people who are going to rise up and soar above the storms of life in Jesus' mighty name. Hallelujah!

Winds of Provision

The wind of God brings unexpected provision and supply. **Numbers 11:31** says:

"Now a wind went out from the Lord, and it brought quail from the sea, and left them fluttering near the camp, about a day's journey on this side and about a day's journey on the other side, all around the camp, and about two cubits above the surface of the ground."

The Israelites had been eating manna daily, and they requested meat. God did not give a little; He provided abundantly. Picture this: quail waist-deep, a day's journey on either side of the camp. Provision came from an unexpected place—the sea. They didn't have to catch it; it was supplied supernaturally.

In 2026, God's wind will bring provision in every area of life—financial, physical, emotional, and relational—from places you never imagined. God will literally create what you need and blow it into your life.

Trust His provision. Receive it with gratitude. Don't complain or take it for granted. Remember that after a while, the Israelites began to complain about the manna and the quail. Don't do that. Rejoice and be grateful; gratitude preserves what the wind delivers.

Our church building will be provided in the same way. Provision will come without human effort, from places you could not foresee. Be ready to receive supernatural supply in abundance.

Winds of Correction

Not all winds are gentle. Sometimes God sends a strong wind to correct. **Jonah 1:4** says:

"But the Lord sent out a great wind on the sea, and there was a mighty tempest on the sea, so that the ship was about to be broken up."

Jonah was running from God, and let me tell you, some of you have got some family members or some kids running from God. Maybe your wife or husband is running from God. The wind of God is about to bring them back, I tell you right now. God's going to send a strong wind to turn it around for them in Jesus' name.

I tell you right now, this nation is headed in the wrong direction. Many are headed in the wrong direction, and God needs to send a mighty wind to America to turn it around. Jonah was running from God, and God sent the wind toward him to turn things around.

Listen, there are some winds and storms that come, and we don't need to rebuke them. They're not attacks, not accidents, and they're not bad luck. They're God's divine intervention to turn things around. It's for course correction. If you need a course correction this year, or maybe you need a course correction right now, you need a strong wind from the Lord to turn things around.

Come on somebody! You should be jumping up and down for that one too. Why? Because **Hebrews 12:6** says:

"For whom the Lord loves, He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives."

So we need correction. I don't know about you, but I want to be correctable. Come on! Say: "Lord, in 2026 I'm going to be correctable and teachable. Don't allow me to get on the ship to go in the wrong direction. Amen!"

If I get foolish, smack me with your wind and turn me around. Get me sent back on the course to the right place! Come on somebody! Resistance increases pressure, but repentance releases peace. Correction is not God rejecting you. Correction is God's mercy and God's love to keep you out of further trouble. Amen!

5

Winds of Revival

We need a strong wind of revival in America. Short of divine intervention, I don't know what's going to happen. Things are not looking very good, but we need the wind. We need the wind that changed the world in **Acts 2:1-4**:

"When the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the house where they were sitting. Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance."

This mighty rushing wind was the Holy Spirit, the wind of God that came with power. It brought power, boldness, unity, and a public witness. We need power in the church. The American church has become so powerless, so watered down, so lukewarm, so comfort- and convenience-driven, and we need power. We need a surge of power in the church. We need the winds of revival to come and resurrect these dry bones of religion and tradition in the church.

We don't need to be secret-friendly; we need to be Holy Ghost-friendly. We don't need to be secret-sensitive; we need to be Holy Ghost-sensitive. We need to be Spirit-sensitive. This is a Spirit-sensitive church. Revival came because they pressed in, praying and waiting.

It was not hype. It was real. It was genuine. It was a move of the Holy Ghost. It was the fire of God. There is no revival without the fire.

I had a pastor ask me some years ago, "Would you come to my church and do a revival but don't do all that fire stuff?" I said, What? I said, there is no revival without the fire. That fire stuff may offend some people. Let them be offended. It only offends the religious. It only offends Pharisees and Sadducees and "Wouldn't Sees" and "Couldn't Sees." We're not catering to Pharisees and Sadducees. They were sad, you see. They were so sad. We're glad here.

When the Lord turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them in that dream because our mouths were filled with laughter and our tongues with singing. They said among the nations, "The Lord has done great things for them." The Lord has done great things for us, and we are glad! It's going to be a year of joy. It's going to be a year of laughter and overflow. We're going to laugh and rejoice like never before. We're going to get smashed in the Holy Ghost more than ever. We're going to get drunk in the Holy Ghost more than ever. We're going to run around the church more than ever. We're going to jump and shout more than ever. Hallelujah! Fire! Fire of the Holy Ghost!

Some of these churches have turned into Madame Tussauds, like the wax museum. We need fire in the wax museum. Fire of the Holy Ghost! And the stronger the wind, the faster the fire spreads! Fuego! Más fuego! We need power. We need boldness. We need greater unity—not with the flesh, but with the Spirit. The Bible talks about the unity of the Spirit. People have forsaken the Spirit. They're trying to be united in the flesh and united around the things of man. No, no, we need to be united in the Spirit. The Bible talks about the unity of the Spirit. Hallelujah!

The wind needs vessels to fill. They were all filled. It needs vessels, not spectators. We've got too many people called looky-loos. They come to look and see, and they're just looky-loos. Don't be a looky-loo. Be a vessel that God can fill. Amen.

We need more Pentecostal power—and I'm not talking about the Pentecostal denomination. Some Pentecostals are so dead; they need to be ashamed to call themselves Pentecostal. All the power in their life put together is not even enough to blow their nose. I once said to a Pentecostal church in Europe, "You guys should be ashamed to call yourselves Pentecostal." I walked in, and it was so dead, I thought I was at a Baptist church. You have a denominational identity, but you lost the power of Pentecost.

I preached a strong word. The pastor, an older gentleman—he's retired now—he was old school, and he was getting excited. But some of the new people there, for example the worship leader, was manifesting. He was coming out of the whole seeker-friendly worship, you know, with the ripped skinny jeans stuff. Back in the days, they were all wearing—what do you call that thing they wear? A beanie. Anyway, I don't have a problem with being cool. You can be cool, but don't be dead. Be anointed cool.

Anyway, moving right along. Listen, when the wind of revival blows, you better be in position. You better be in the right place at the right time. Paul says that Jesus appeared to 500 of the brethren after the resurrection, but on the day of Pentecost, there were only 120 there. What happened to the other 380? They couldn't wait. They couldn't wait a week. Amen.

6

Winds of Expansion

The Lord really dropped this in my spirit today: the winds of expansion. There's going to be a divine wind for increase.

Zechariah 2:6: "For I have spread you abroad like the four winds of heaven."

So this is like a wind in four directions. This is like stretching forth. This is expansion. There's going to be an expansion in 2026. There's going to be a major, massive expansion of this church and this ministry in 2026. Hallelujah! You think 2025 was good? Get ready. Wait until you see the expansion that's coming in 2026.

God's going to send us outward, expand us, and stretch us out. He's going to stretch out our tent. He's going to enlarge our territory. Get ready for the winds of expansion in your business. If you have a kingdom business, lift your hands. I decree and declare winds of expansion over your kingdom business this year. Take it!

God's going to stretch and reposition you. Expansion is going to feel uncomfortable, but it is intentional and necessary. Staying where God once moved is disobedience. He may change direction. He may spiritually or mentally relocate you, even from one industry to another, or from one area to another. Where you're functioning in one area, He is going to move you to another area where you're going to be more

fruitful. Don't be stuck. Hallelujah!

Don't resist divine movements. The wind also spreads influence. God's going to increase and spread our influence in 2026.

Winds of Doctrine

The Lord has also had me speaking on this, and this is a warning to the church of winds of doctrine. The enemy also has a plan. The enemy is also going to be blowing some winds—some contrary winds. Just like when Jesus said, “Get to the other side,” and they were going on the boat and the winds came to stop them. There will be winds of resistance that will come from the enemy, but you will overcome them.

But the Lord, the Spirit expressly says in 2026 it’s going to be a year of major winds of doctrine that are going to blow through the church to confuse people. This comes as a warning.

Ephesians 4:11–15:

“And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers.”

I’m going to say, as an apostle of the Lord, and I’m going to speak this: I have certain things that I have a divine mandate to speak. Some people don’t like it. I don’t really care.

“...for the equipping of the saints for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine.”

These are false doctrines that blow through the church, right? Deceptions blow through. **“...by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting.”**

We are at a time of heightened end-time deception. Winds of deception are blowing like never before. People are very confused because nothing is as it seems. We're dealing with a lot of cunning craftiness, deceitful plotting, and trickery of men. Obviously, they're led by doctrines of devils and seducing and deceiving spirits. We know our battle is not against flesh and blood, but we need to be very careful.

“...but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ.”

So this is very important, that we are grounded on sound doctrine and that we are under the cover of solid spiritual authority, and not be some vagabond floating here and there. These people are going to be easily tossed to and fro, and the American church has been in a very dangerous place the last two decades because of this whole seeker-friendly, little-substance, surface-level Christianity. They haven't been prepared for what's coming. They're children.

So this comes, I know, on a somber note, but this is very, very important to understand. The Bible clearly teaches that these winds of doctrine are doctrinal movements. They're not just individual errors. It sweeps masses of people into it. They're driven by men and used by the devil. It's not from God. It appears godly, but it's not. They're crafty, deceptive, and unstable, and it requires a lot of discernment to be filled with the Holy Ghost and to be connected, to be under cover and accountable, and spiritually accountable to the Holy Spirit, to the Word, and to spiritual authority.

You need to surround yourself and put yourself in the right environment. On the day of Pentecost, they were in the upper room together—the 120. The other 380 got blown away already by other winds. Just in that ten days, the wind took 380 (a majority) and swept them away.

These doctrines are designed to move believers, not ground them. They affect immature Christians most easily. That's why we have to mature in the things of God. We have to be grounded, and we have to be under sound doctrine with good, solid teaching, and be under the anointing, and to develop spiritual discernment—a spiritual taste, a spiritual smell, and a spiritual sense for the things of God. Right? It's very, very important.

I say this as a warning because I have to also bring the other side, right?

So that means there's also winds of judgment that come. We see in the Bible there's winds of judgment that come. A lot of these structures of man and these false things are going to be judged, and God is going to begin to deal with them. But many will be swept away because they're not ready.

My job is to get people ready and to keep people ready. I'm going to have to give an account to God. I'm going to stand before God and give an account. The teacher suffers double judgment. Everybody wants to get double honor, but there's also double judgment for the things that we teach and preach.

We have to walk in the fear of God like never before. The fear of God is what keeps us grounded in the things of God. We have to be grounded and perfecting holiness in our lives. We have to walk in the fear of God and holiness, without which no man will see the Lord.

We've developed this casual, wishy-washy, slippery grace and Christianity where people are not accountable, and there's no fear of God left in the church. People just live anyhow, and they claim grace. It's disgrace. It's terrible. And that's why many have been set up to fall because of this lack of fear of God.

Closing Prayer

Father, in the mighty name of Jesus, may we go into 2026 with the fear of the Lord like never before. Put the fear of God in our hearts. May the fear of God burn in our hearts. May the fear of God ground us and anchor us. Fill us with the Spirit of the fear of the Lord. Thank You, Lord, that we fear God. We fear no man. We do not fear men who can destroy the body. We fear God, who can cast both spirit and soul into hell. We're going to walk in the fear of God.

Lord, let the fear of God keep us stable and grounded, and within the boundaries of the Word and Your will, plan, and purpose. May we not turn to the left or to the right in 2026. May we walk in a holy fear and receive these winds of change, deliverance, protection, provision, revival, expansion, and winds of correction and adjustment in our lives.

We thank You for the wind of heaven. We thank You for the Holy Ghost. We thank You for the provision. We thank You, Holy Spirit. We honor You, Holy Spirit. We give You reverence. We will not play around with the anointing and the things of God. We will walk and live holy, pure lives, walk in the fear of the Lord, and carry an anointing that scares the devil and leaves him shaking.

As mighty men and women of God, we will come with the fire of the Holy Ghost, full of faith and anointing, and we are going to be a threat to the enemy's kingdom. He is afraid of what's coming. He knows what's coming, and he can't stop it. There's an unstoppable force coming. No matter what blocks he tries to put in the way of the wind, nothing can stand in the way of the wind of the Holy Ghost, Amen. Hallelujah! Thank You, Jesus.

(If they respond with anything but "I have Jesus in my heart" or something similar to that, PROCEED WITH SCRIPT) or "No" or "I hope so" PROCEED WITH SCRIPT.]

Let me quickly share with you what the Holy Bible reads. It reads "for all have sinned and come short of the glory of God" and "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord". The Bible also reads, "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved". And you're a "whosoever" right? Of course you are; all of us are.
